


Foreign Voices Of Ichinoseki!



Recipe Box

Meiple Scones

3 Cups flour

1 Tablespoon Baking Powder

1/2 teaspoon Salt

1/3 cups Brown Sugar

1/2 Cup Butter

2 Eggs, lightly beaten

1/2 Cup Maple Syrup

1 Cup Powdered Sugar

2 Tablespoons Maple Syrup


1/8 teaspoon Cinnamon

1/8 teaspoon Nutmeg

2 teaspoons milk

To make Glaze:

Mix all the ingredients together.



Preheat oven to 220 celcius

Mix flour, baking powder, salt and sugar. Add butter, mix lightly. Stir in eggs and maple syrup. Put dough on a lightly floured surface and knead. Roll dough out into 1/2 inch thick. Cut into 8 pieces. Bake for 15-20 minutes


